With the present I beg to request the favour of an interview in re the following matter:

On the 12th of August, 1910, the Deutsch - Englische Ost Afrika Kompagnie of Berlin, whose interests I am here representing, applied formally for a fibre concession in the East Africa Protectorate on a tract of land for which they have already paid. Subject to a letter received by them from you on the 19th of August, 1910 (No. 26,026/10) a further reply was promised which however they regret not to have received. As the matter is most urgent, I should deem myself happy if I were permitted to submit the facts once again personally.
