I am directed by Mr. Secretary Harcourt to inform you that, subject to your being passed as physically fit for service, he proposes to select you for probationary appointment as an ⁱⁿ ~~Assistant~~ ^{that capacity} Inspector of Police in the East Africa Protectorate with salary at the rate of £150 per annum, and £10 per annum uniform allowance. Quarters are provided for you (but not of rates or similar allowances) or an allowance is given in lieu thereof. An Inspector ranks as a non-commissioned officer.

A memorandum of the general conditions attached to appointments on the Protectorate is enclosed herewith and you are to understand that you will be subject to the regulations which may hereafter be introduced by or with the sanction of the Secretary of State. Copies of the Regulations as to pensions and the Colonial Relations are also enclosed, but you will not acquire pension rights until the satisfactory conclusion of a probationary period of 3 years.
