No. 6. Your despatch of 28th November No. 691
subject to your approval I propose to introduce bill
and approve Ordinance to repeal Ordinance No. 5 of
1911 and to make provision only to enable a Court to
order a defaulter against whom proceedings are taken
under section 7 of Ordinance No. 1 of 1911 to pay cost
of such proceedings. It is most important that Court
should have such power as in some districts tax is
never paid until proceedings are taken. Proceedings
under Ordinance No. 12 of 1908 was in the nature of
civil proceedings and the Court has power to order
costs to be paid by defaulter apart from any other
provision in the Ordinance. I do not press (for)
other provisions in the Ordinance No. 5 of 1911.
