Your telegram of 4th January, should like
question of secretariat salaries remain in abeyance
till my arrival in England. Propose that Evans be
promoted to fill Granville's vacancy. The filling

cer should be transferred from the Administration.
Therefore suggest that an additional Assistant-District

owing to officers proceeding on leave I hope that ^{extra} ad-
ministrative officers asked for in Estimates for next
year will arrive as soon as possible after 1st April.
