My dear Mason,

We have at last obtained from East Africa information which enables us to answer the question which you asked in the House of Commons last June. The delay has been due to the failure of the Acting Governor in the first instance, to give us the exact particulars for which we asked, so that we had to write to him twice.

It is stated that some 3,000 nectare, 15,000 head of cattle, and 250,000 sheep were formerly located on the lands now held by the East Africa Syndicate; when the Masai were moved into the reserves they were moved from the Syndicate's concession as well as from other land in the Rift Valley. Without this movement the land would not have been available for

occurred by the Syndicate, but there was no financial
removal on that account alone, it was part of the
general suspense.

As regards to the present commitment at
the present time, the amount is as follows:
The syndicate's position is carrying about \$
10,000,000.00, which is not known.
The book value of diversities on the P.M. held by the
