My dear Sir,

We have at last obtained from East Africa information which enables us to answer the question which you asked in the House of Commons last June. The delay has been due to the failure of the Acting Governor in the first instance, to give us the exact particulars for which we asked, so that we had to write to him twice.

It is stated that some 3,000 people, 15,000 head of cattle, and 250,000 sheep were formerly located on the lines now held by the East Africa Syndicate; when the Masai were moved into the Reserves, they were moved from the Syndicate's concession as well as from other land in the Rift Valley. Without this movement the land would not have been available for

occupation by the syndicate, but there was no specific
removal on that account alone, it was part of the
general movement.

As to the number of inhabitants at
the present time, they are known to be about

the inhabitants: European, striking about 40
and the total head of livestock on the P. held by the
syndicate at the end of November last was 10,000, of
which 10,000 were sheep.
