EAST AFRICA PROTECTORATE.

AN ORDINANCE

To 7 of 1007

To amend the Master and Servants Ordinance, 1906.

Be it enacted by the Governor of the East Africa Protectorate with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof:—

This Ordinance may be cited as the Master and Servants Ordinance shore who
is 7, and shall be read as one with the Master and Servants Ordinance, 1906.

Any written contract of service entered into in British Isdia for service in the Bast Africa Protectorate shall if it shall have been executed and attested in the manner prescribed by the Indian Emigration Act 1883 or by any law for the time being in force in British India relating to the Emigration of Natures of India be deemed to have been executed in conformity with the Master and Servants Ordinance 1906 anything in Section 37 of the said Ordinance to the contrary notwithstanding.

(2) Any such contract of service shall be deemed to have been made, executed, and attested in conformity with the laws in force in British India, if it shall bear the attesting signature of an Officer or other person purporting to be a person authorised by law to attest such contracts, unless it shall be proved-that such person

was not so authorised.
