My Lord,

In reply to Your Lordship's despatch Confidential (4) of October 28th I have the honour to report that the Nandi prisoners referred to were interned at Mombasa under the "Removal of Natives into Special Districts Ordinance" mentioned in paragraph 8 of Your Lordship's despatch. I regret that it was erroneously reported in my despatch No. 366 that this action was taken under the provisions of the Order-in-Council.

With reference to paragraph 8 of Your Lordship's despatch undesignate, instructions have been issued and half yearly reports will be submitted as to the reason necessitating the detention of the prisoners.

The Jubaland offenders referred to in paragraph 8 have
