My Lord,

I have the honour to request to be informed as to the position of the officials of the Legal Department with reference to the matter of pension.

It is provided by XII Vic. Cap 20 that professional men who enter the service at a later date than that on which non-professional men enter it may be granted a number of years in addition to their years of actual service to be reckoned in computing their pension.

This provision is, however, subject to section 4 of the Act which states that such allowance shall be subject to Treasury Orders and Warrants. These orders are, I believe, not presenable in the Privy Council and I should be much obliged if Your Excellency would think fit to give information on the matter and also be supplied with copies of the Treasury Orders dealing therewith.
