Your Excellency,

I have the honour to request to be informed as to the position of the Officers of the Legal Department with reference to the matter of pension.

It is provided by VIII Vic. Cap 24 that professional men who enter the service at a later date than that at which non-professional men enter it may be granted a number of years in addition to their years of actual service to be reckoned in computing their pensions.

This provision is, however, subject to Section 4 of the Act which states that such allowance shall be subject to Treasury Orders and Warrants. These orders are, I believe, not procurable in the provinces and I should be much obliged if Your Excellency would think fit to enquire for information on the matter and also to be supplied with copies of the Treasury Orders dealing with it.
