With reference to your letter No. 27317/1907 of the 23rd of August and previous correspondence respecting the concession which it is proposed to grant to Mongolia Limited for the lease of land in the East African Protectorate, I have the honour to inform you that a question has arisen as to the position of the land to be leased. The plan enclosed in your letter of the 27th July 1906† appears unfortunately to have been mislaid, but I enclose a copy of a A B & C letter which we have received from our solicitors on the subject, with its enclosures in original and have to ask for the Secretary of State's instructions as to whether Plan B is the one to be adopted.

Gentlemen,

EAST AFRICA PROTECTORATE
TANA RIVER CONCESSION.

In further reference to your letter of the 26th ultimo and our interview with you yesterday, Mr. Woodhouse, in accordance with our request, has called upon us to-day and informs us that the plan on the large scale (marked "A" now enclosed, shows the limits of the proposed concession by the dotted lines, these limits, Mr. Woodhouse states, having been approved of by the authorities in the Colony. In subsequent interviews with the Colonial Office, Mr. Woodhouse further states that the limits of the Concession as thus marked, have been from time to time accepted by the Colonial Office.

The accompanying reduced plan, marked "B" shows the limits of this Concession as delineated upon the larger plan. It is a copy of such part of this reduced plan, as far as it shows the limits of the lands proposed to be leased, that we suggest should be annexed to the Concession.

We should add that at one time it was suggested that the limits of the Concession should be within the line shown in red on the further copy reduced plan also sent herewith marked "C" but on objections being raised to this Mr. Woodhouse informs us that this proposal was abandoned and the original proposition adhered to.
