In reply to Mr. Antrobus's letter of the 19th
ultim^o (28906/1906), I am directed by the Lords Commis-
sioners of His Majesty's Treasury to state, for the informa-
tion of the Earl of Elgin, that They sanction the grant to
Mr. C. Wise, Assistant Collector in the British East Africa
Protectorate, of a pension from Protectorate funds of
£22.3.4, calculated upon a service (including climate
addition) of 17 completed years.

It would not be in accordance with the practice of
the Treasury under the Superannuation Acts to include
fractions of a year in the computation of pension.
