ultimo in which the Earl of Elgin submits for Their opinion
the guestion whether a Government Medical Officer is entitled
to claim fees for expert evidence given in a court of law
on behalf of the Grown

In reply I am to state that in similar cases in the Home Civil Service My Lords have ruled that a full-time salaried officer of Government who attends a trial as an expert witness, without forfeiting his salary for the day are days in question, has no claim to remuneration, and may only require his actual expenses of locamotion and subsistence allowance at the rate which he is ordinarily antitled to draw when travelling on the public service.

In applying this principle to the African
Protectorates it may be more convenient to allow actual and
reasonable out of pocket expenses.

I am to add that Their Lordships have further decided that any fee which the panty who has subpoemed such an efficer may be liable to pay for expert evidence belongs to the State as the equivalent for the efficer's time; and that if the Officer receives such a fee, he must pay it into the Exchequer.
