Sir,

In reply to Mr. Antrobus's letter (13495/1907) of the 26th April last, I am to request you to convey to the Earl of Elgin the sanction of the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury for the proposed alterations in the rates of pay and conditions of service for the Chief Engineers on the Lake Steamers of the Uganda Railway, in virtue of which—

(1) salaries will be at the rate of Rs.350 per mensem, rising to Rs.450 per mensem, promotion beyond the rate of Rs.400 per mensem being given for approved service only and in annual increments of not more than Rs.15 per mensem; and

(2) Chief Engineers will be eligible for promotion to Officer's rank after completing one year's service, provided that they hold a Chief Engineer's certificate and are suitable in other respects; it being understood that promotion to Officers rank will not carry with it any claim to pension rights.
