In reply to Mr. Antrobus's letter of the 2nd instant (21183/1907), I am directed by the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury to request you to inform the Earl of Elgin that Their Lordships assent --- to the service of Captain E.E. Farnall, of the Uganda Railway Department, Commander of the ~~Motor~~ Steamer "Wiwifred", being made payable with effect from the date on which he entered the Protectorate Service, subject to the conditions specified in the sixth paragraph of the Treasury letter of 2nd September 1904 (No. 14968/04) and (2) to the reduction of Captain Farnall's salary from £450 to £425 per annum rising by two annual increments of £10 and one of £5 to £450 per annum.
