Sir,

I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Just's letter (28603/1907) of the 29th ultimo forwarding a revised estimate of the cost to 31st March next of the Native Affairs Department in the East Africa Protectorate, which provides for an expenditure of £3,219 in 9 months as against the original estimate of £2,265 for the year.

I am to request you to inform the Earl of Elgin that in view of the explanations submitted by Lords sanction the proposed expenditure, on the understanding that the item for local travelling will be reduced by £500, and that the whole department will be regarded as being on an experimental footing pending further experience.

My Lords would ask the Secretary of State to consider if it is necessary to make special presents to Chiefs in respect of the Department of Native Affairs having regard to the general subsidies and presents provided for the Protectorate Estimates under the head of Provincial Administration.
