Sir,

I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Antrebus' letter of the 22nd ultimo (38885/1907) and its enclosures, respecting the case of Mr. R. Barton Wright, Land Officer in the East Africa Protectorate, who asks that his previous temporary service as an Assistant Engineer on the Uganda Railway may be included in the calculation of his pension on retirement.

In reply I am directed to acquaint you for the information of the Secretary of State for the Colonies that, in an analogous case in the Home service, the previous employment would not be counted for pension; and My Lords regret that They therefore feel Themselves precluded, as in the cases of Dr. W. Waters and Mr. L.E. Gaine, dealt with in the letters from this Department to the Foreign Office of the 29th June 1901 and the 8th December 1902 respectively, from acceding to Mr. Wright's application.
