Sir,

I am directed by the Secretary of State for the Colonies to inform you that, subject to your being fitted and financially fit for service, he proposes to select you for probationary appointment as an Assistant District Commissioner in the East Africa Protectorate with salary at the rate of £250 per year and five quarters or an allowance in lieu thereof.

A memorandum showing the general conditions attached to appointments in the Protectorate is enclosed herewith, but you are to understand that you will be subject to any regulations which may hereafter be introduced by us with the sanction of the Secretary of State. A copy of the regulations as to pensions is also enclosed.

You are also to understand that you will be available for employment in any appointment which the Governor of the Protectorate may direct, and it will be within his discretion to recommend to the Secretary of State your transfer to another branch of the administration if he sees fit to do so.
