Sir,

With reference to your letter No. 33383 of the 28^a September last; I have the honor to lay before you the following considerations with regard to Lord Elgin's ruling informing me that "his lordship has not been able to approve of the payment of the fees for the course from Government funds, or of any lodging or other allowance in respect of it."

1. My Deputy, Mr. Brandt, had his post-graduate class fees paid from Government funds.

2. The special leave granted me to make my visit to the South African Colonies was not leave of absence but was for the purpose of an official visit to consult with the Viceroy of those colonies so as to assist me in my work in East Africa, and I have already had the honor to forward

Downing Street.

3. Since my return to England
the rest of my time has been
occupied in veterinary & parasitological
and scientific investigations, and
as you are no doubt aware I was
for three weeks in Chile on
Lord Elanor's estate carrying
out experiments with piped & treated
African red water, and at present
I am working in the Board
of Agriculture laboratory where
I have been since the
beginning of November.

You will therefore see that
my holiday & fee has been
particularly taken up with
veterinary work which I trust will
be of benefit to the East-
African Fisheries.

Mr. Smith from whom I made
my alterations in London here
stated that the considerable personal
expenses and therefore last but
no. matter will receive your kind
& favourable consideration.
