No. 12. Referring to my telegram of 20th January Foran
(with) fifty police has arrived at Kisii, Pois (with)
fifty rifles closely following. Killed in action two
police eleven porters. Hemsted and party (of) police
also have arrived at Kisii from Karungu. Kisii people
by latest reports have moved cattle preparing to fight.
Full enquiry will be made as to causes, generally
believed to be due (to) with doctor inimical to
Europeans. Mackay (and) two companies of King's
African Rifles arrived yesterday noon Kongo Bay.
Suppression of trouble should not take long.
After that propose to station one company of King's
African Rifles (at) Kisii.
