My Lord,

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of Your Lordship's despatch No. 674 of December 13th transmitting correspondence with Mr. E. P. Cobb on the subject of roads in this Protectorate.

2. I propose shortly to establish Road Boards in the various provinces, composed of the Provincial Commissioner, a member of the Public Works Department and two non-official members, who will report on the general question of roads.

3. I am of opinion that it would be advisable to place Mr. Cobbs letter before these Boards and to consider their recommendations. I would then address Your Lordship further on this subject.
