Re. In the eighth paragraph of your despatch no acknowledgement is made of the statement that Sergeant Instructors Wilson and Richardson were confirmed in the appointment of Inspector. I would like to add that they have been appointed as Inspectors of Police in accordance with the instructions contained in the opening paragraph of Sir Lorn's despatch No. 646 of October 17th 1906 in which such confirmation is approved.

6. The uniform allowance to Inspectors, as to which information is requested in the eighth paragraph of Lord Duggin's No. 611 of the 7th November 1907, is at the rate of £10/- per annum but is only paid when the uniform has actually been purchased, verified bills notwithstanding that amount being accepted by the Treasury.


