My Lord,

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt
of Your Lordship's despatch No. 498 of the 7th ultimo,
together with the original drawings in connection with
the survey of the southern portion of Lake Victoria.

The General Manager of the Railway informs
me that should the Admiralty require these drawings
they can be returned temporarily, but that in his
opinion it is advisable to retain them in the Protecto-
rate until the whole lake has been systematically
surveyed, and this cannot be done for some consider-
able time yet.
