Sir,

In reply to Mr. Antrobus's letter of the 3rd instant (19722/1908), I am to request you to inform the Earl of Crews that the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury agree that the service of Captain W.H.M. Townsend of the Uganda Railway Lake Steamer Service may, on the 17th instant, be made pensionable with effect from the date on which he joined the Railway, subject to the conditions specified in the fourth paragraph of the Manager's letter of the 20th April last, and to the further condition that his salary shall remain at £420 until 15th July 1909, and be thereafter increased by annual increments of 20 to £450 per annum.
