Sir,

In the circumstances explained in Mr. Antrobus's letter of the 3rd instant (22187/1908), I am to request you to inform Secretary the Earl of Crowe that the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury sanction the repayment to Mr. Zaphiro, the Inspector of the Anglo Abyssinian Boundary in East Africa, from the funds of the East Africa Protectorate, of the out of pocket expenses, amounting to £330 for the period to 24th April last, incurred by him in excess of the authorised total expenditure for the service.

This sanction is given on the understanding that Mr. Zaphiro will in future be required to confine his total expenditure within the authorised limit of £900 per annum.
