23262 In reply to Mr. Antrobus's letter (23262/1908) of
the 17th instant, I am to say, for the information of the
Earl of Crewe, that the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's
Treasury agree that the post of Senior Inspector of Farms
~~in the East Africa Protectorate~~ may during Mr. Scholefield's
tenure, (only), carry pensionable rights.

I am however to point out that the salary of
£325 per annum was assigned to the post on a non-pensionable
basis; for the time during which the post will be regarded
as pensionable the salary should in Their Lordships opinion
be fixed at £300 per annum.
