In reply to Mr. Antrobus's letter (23092/1908) of the 17th ultimo I am to say, for the information of the Earl of Crewe, that in view of the further explanations now given the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury sanction the appointment of Mr. O. Mitchell as permanent Assistant in the Customs Department of the East Africa Protectorate with a salary of £300 - £10 - £400 a year, on the understanding that he will replace one of the European Inspectors at £200 per annum for whom provision is made in the Estimates.
