In reply to Mr. antrobase 1 to (30000, 1808) in 15th Anstant, I am to say, for the formation of scretcry the Earl of Crowe, that the Lord Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury agree that the re-formant of the Uganda Railway between Mazeras (mile f5) and Maskinger Road (mile 62) may be completed as planned, even thanks that cost will exceed by £14.157 the original estimate.
