I have the honour to inform you that Ole Lelit, Samburu Chief, yesterday reported that the Abyssinians raided two Rendile villages about a month ago at Mount Rulol, taking the goats and sheep but leaving the camels also killing one man and wounding another.

Kuiol is, I think, situated to the North of the General wathew Range and is not far East from the S.E. Corner of Lake Rudolf.

A number of the sheep raided belonged to Lebaranty, brother of the Lelit.

ne warro, an old Rendils man was the owner of one of the Kreals raided.

Ole Lelit was certain that this raid was quite distinct from that, about which I find there was some correspondence in August.

I have told Ole Lelit to make every enderwour to send in to this Station one or mole of the men who were in the Rendile village at the time of the raid.

If these come in I will send them to you, as it is possebly enat you may wish to question them.

Extract from Mr Zaphiro's report dated on South OH

The Abyssinians have labely changed their policy concerning the Frontier, being aware that I have no more than twenty to thirty seldiers to ratrol a populous country, and a line of four hundred siles long, they take no notice of me, and are crossing the line by hundreds, destroying the elephants and orpressing the natives on our side. These, seeing that their complaints are disregarded commence to lose confidence, many or them crossing the line so as to avoid the Abyssinian hunters.

A reid was made lately by Pitareuri Immani's soldiers (Governor of Tomenichs, north of Gardula who is under Fitareuri Hapta Giorgis) on the west side of Rudolf (British soil). This raid was accompanied by a European; it is reported they killed many natives and took numberless cattle and dorkeys.

You will see that all the officers and principal minters who have had trouble with me have been promoted and those who befriended me were dismissed, e.g. Basha Wold Sabriel. The hunters Desta, Zerefu and seven others who continually went to the south of the line to rill elephants have been promoted by the Emperor himself.

pataly the principal hunter desta arrived here with thirty soldiers, he was supposed to have a letter from the Superor to bill elephants on the north of the line I had neve of his arrival and watched his carefully; he killed elevan elephants near the line, but was add satisfied, and crossed the line at Toraha where he killed seven elephants. I got hold of one of his soldiers with his ritis, and I also conficuated his flour.
