I have the honour to report that considerable difficulty has been experienced in carrying out the instructions issued in accordance with the concluding paragraph of Your Lordship's despatch No. 445 of September 3rd last.

2. Many of the Protectorate jails are unsuited for executions, owing to the lack of a sufficiently extensive open space within the walls.

3. I presume that in such circumstances there is no objection to the execution taking place in some private spot in the vicinity of the jail.
