These posts are filled by Non-Commissioned Officere of the Royal Army Medical Corps all, but the last, serving on their Army engagement, so the question of the retention of an outfit allowance for civilians does not affect this service.

The retention of an outfit allowance for soldiers seconded from their corps is, I think, a just and equitable allowance. The prevision of a trepical outfit would bear hardly on them as compared with a civilian, who could probably utilise a great deal of his home kit.

Besides, the necessity of suddenly being called on to spend £50 or £50 on pracceding to take up a new appointment sould weigh heavily on a number of suitable candidator, and militate seriesely against this service being possible with a very designable class of mon.
