Sir,

I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Antrobus' letter of the 27th ultimo (9694/1909) with its enclosures respecting the re-allocation of a sum of £3,000 from Uganda Railway Capital Account Estimate No. 15 Minor Bridges, towards the provision of extra accommodation at Nairobi and Port Florence.

In reply I am to request you to inform the Earl of Crewe that My Lords sanction this proposal on the understanding that the amount of the excess, authorised by the letter from this Department of 28th October last (17058/08), incurred on the re-alignment of the Railway, will be met by reductions under other heads of the capital account and that the total estimate of further capital expenditure will not be increased in consequence of that authority or of the present proposal.
