Sir,

The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury have had before Them Mr. Antrobus's letter of the 31st May last relative to the proposals of the Manager of the Uganda Railway for a further reduction of freight on imported stock from 31 cents to 25 cents and a reduction on other than imported stock from 50 cents to 35 cents per vehicle mile.

Their Lordships observe that even the present rate for imported stock is slightly below the average actual cost, so that a 25 cents rate would apparently involve a very appreciable loss, and I am to say for the information of the Earl of Crewe that They regret that They feel precluded from entertaining the present proposals, at any rate until the reports on the general results of the previous experimental reductions are before Them.

Such reports will doubtless show the proportions in which imported and non-imported stock are carried respectively.
