My Lord,

With reference to Mr. Jackson's despatch No. 605 of October 22nd last, respecting difficulties which may arise in connection with Missions of whose methods and objects we have imperfect information, I have the honour to transmit herewith a list of those Societies which are already represented in this Protectorate together with a map showing the spheres within which they are permitted to carry on evangelistic work.

2. The figures are necessarily incomplete but are in accordance with the replies received to the enquiries which I caused to be made.

3. I would venture to ask that no application from any other missionary body be entertained by Your Lordship without previous reference to me accompanied by a statement of its financial position and objects. Foreign Societies should, I think,
