My Lord,

I have to report that through an oversight the salary of the Medical Officer of Health, Mombasa, was inserted in the draft Estimates for 1910-11 on the scale £500 by £25 to £600 whereas the sanctioned annual increments are £20 only.

2. When the recommendations were made for the creation of the new grade of Senior Medical Officer it was intended that the scale of salary should be the same as that of the Medical Officer of Health, Mombasa.

3. Owing to the error above recorded the scale was inadvertently inserted as £500 by £25 to £600 and the proposal has received Your Lordship's approval.

4. I would propose therefore that, unless Your Lordship has any objection, the appointments to these posts should be on the £500 by £20 to £600 scale, that is the same as the sanctioned scale of the Medical Officer of Health at Mombasa, who is senior to the proposed Senior Medical Officers.
