My Lord,

With further reference to head 21 paragraph 8 of Your Lordship's despatch No. 129 of the 11th ultimo, in which I am asked to state the present position as regards the establishment of a system of wireless telegraphy between this protectorate, Italian Somaliland and Zanzibar I have the honour to report that I do not see my way to incurring expenditure in this connection at present.

2. The Postmaster General is however in domestic official communication with the Italian Legation and it is possible that the latter may be prepared to erect and work an installation at Mombasa at their own expense, under an agreement giving the government power to take over later on if desired.
