Arrival of Gedu.

Gedu, the Boran Chief from Abyssints territory, has arrived here and asks me to hand back to him some Boran who have fled from his sountry and entered British territory. I have intermed him that if these people want to return to him they can do so, but that it is not the British custom to hand back to another Native people who have entered our territory and committed no erise. Sets is accompanied by a few Abyssinian soldiers and number of his Boran.

Also that the Gurre are rapidly buying rifles from the Abyssinians. Sheriff Deri's messenger informs me that he has himself seen many rifles in their possession.
