My Lord,

I have to report that some confusion has arisen with regard to the European Staff of the Prison Department with the result that the Department has now one more official than is provided for in the estimates.

2. The mistake has occurred through the system of decentralization which at present exists in the Prison Department, each of the Prisons at the various Provincial centres being in charge of the Provincial Commissioner of the Province, and though "Prisons" forms one heading in the Estimates and the various posts are regarded as interchangeable, there is no
