My Lord,

The case of an old Swahili named Shaha Athman has recently been brought before me.

2. His first recorded service is as a soldier in the employ of Sultan Seyid Bargash in 1888, and since that date he has worked continuously for the successive Sultans of Zanzibar, the Imperial British East Africa Company and the Government: he is now an old man and past all work but he has been a faithful servant and

I am anxious to afford him some slight assistance during the closing years of his life.
