Sir,

With reference to your telegram of the 14th instant, I have to say that you recently sent with your telegram to the British Consul at Mombasa, purporting to be signed by me, and which was serving a term of imprisonment, for which he was sent here last year for an offence committed by him in the State of Kenya, I have requested by Colonel Hayes-Sadler to inform you that he has made inquiries with regard to the prisoner's state of health and has been told that he is an officer of the prison in which he has been detained. His health has considerably improved since he was first admitted.

As, however, McLeish is still serving his sentence, he appears to be anxious about his health. He has been at Mombasa some months, and last Saturday he made his removal to Nairobi where he will serve the remainder of his sentence of imprisonment. This step was taken, as Colonel Hayes-Sadler already informed you, before the remit by him in his telegram of the 14th instant.

His Majesty's Commissioner observes that the status of McLeish being an American citizen has nothing to do with him, and that he is not aware of what steps could be made. He also, however, considers that the removal of his trial and he sees no reason which would justify him in ordering his release before the expiration of the imprisonment to which he has been sentenced.

Territory Ordinance 1942.

The following amendment made recently with the
existing order may be inserted by the end of
the effectiveness of the order made before the following
Ordinance.

The drafter of the Criminal Ordinance intended
to make provision for the punishment of a person
who has failed to respond to a summons, and to give the Commissioner power by rule
to authorise holding overprize and for persons to
remove a witness which the person required by law
has failed to respond.

No rules regulating holding and removal shall
be issued except where such power
is given under the Ordinance.
