In former Sotik raided Massai 6 weeks ago killing some women and children & capturing cattle unable to obtain peaceable separation. Report measures taken. Does not anticipate trouble with other tribes.

Six weeks ago Sotik raided Masai killing some women and children and capturing large numbers of cattle. Notwithstanding every effort to obtain reparation peaceably Sotik refused to pay or to receive messengers. Am sending two patrols at the end of this month if cattle not returned by then and in the meantime am sending half Company to protect settlers. Movement purely confined to Sotik; anticipate no trouble with other tribes.
