After consulting the publications attached to the post

of elementary mistress I am advised at Naurodi with those

in India regarding African colonies a definite regard to the
salaries paid to the members of the general staff of a school,
and a third class teacher. In this case candidate should be
offered a salary of Rs. 100 a month, it being understood

that she will be allowed free residence, her board and lodgings

and a small sum for subsistence is asked.

In similar cases, the teacher selected

will be required to take charge from her new Master or Destination.

MAKROBI, EAST AFRICA PROTECTORATE.

I am directed by the Board of Education to acknowledge receipt of your letter, dated June 11, from Mr. Antrobus, thank you for the information it contains.

After comparing all the conditions attached to the post of Under-Primary Mistress in the School at Nairobi with those existing in other African colonies and having regard to the salaries paid to the members of the present staff of the School, I find it would be reasonable to suggest that a suitable candidate should be offered a salary of Rs. 150 per month, it being understood that he will be allowed free passage to the world, says no provision is made for his return passage. This suggestion is based partly upon the fact that in similar cases, the teacher selected has always been given a free passage from her first to her destination. Would the Mistress like candidates selected for good conduct and teaching ability?
