C.O. No. 60 dated 26th Jan. forwarding correspondence regarding applications made by the late Mr. Frankhauser and his heirs of the Mangrove Trading and Development Syndicate.

1. Mangrove concessions at Vanga and Mahalau. The Syndicate was informed in January that the mangrove areas near Vanga are already leased, and there are objections for the present to allowing white men to settle and work mangrove in Mahalau and Jubalau. An application by Messrs Smith, Mackenzie and Co. for the same area has been refused on similar grounds.
2. There is no application for 200 acres between Mangarini and the Satali River. There is one of 5000 acres at Momburi by the Syndicate, not put in by Mr. Frankhauser, but in this case no definite area has yet been applied for.
3. Cotton lands on the Tivi Gazi Road. No trace of any application by Mr. Frankhauser. As a fact this area is inside that applied for by the Goldman-Thomas Syndicate.
4. 80 square miles near Taveta. This was applied for as a fibre concession, but was found to be good agricultural land. Moreover it had already been applied for by others. The Land Office sent a reply to the Syndicate in January. This was one of the claims put in by the Syndicate to the General Office.
