I am directed by the Secretary of State for the Colonies to inform you that, on completion of your regulation, Officers, and European
~~subalterns~~ of Colonial force, from all the various East and West African
Colonies and Protectorates are now required to attend a course of instruction
and training at the Depot of the Royal Irish Constabulary in Dublin, either in
first appointment or during their term of service in this country.

a. The duration of the course and the number of subjects in which
~~instruction~~ will be given, will naturally depend upon the qualifications and
qualifications of each individual officer. It will not, however, exceed one
month.

b. I am directing you to report yourself to the
Commandant of the Royal Irish Constabulary Depot, Phoenix Park, Dublin,
on the day of the ~~marking~~ ~~day~~ of your arrival from
~~the~~ ~~marking~~ ~~day~~ of your embarkation.

c. While you are attached to this Depot you will be subject to the
~~Commandant~~ ~~of~~ ~~the~~ ~~Depot~~ ~~and~~ ~~any~~ ~~other~~ ~~instructions~~ ~~which~~ ~~may~~ ~~be~~ ~~given~~

d. The initial fees for instruction are defrayed by Government, and
you will be entitled, except in the contingencies hereinafter stated, to receive
pay and allowances during the course at the following rates:

e. Officers of the ~~Constabulary~~ ~~of~~ ~~the~~ ~~Irish~~ ~~Volunteers~~ are ordinarily enlisted under
the same regulations, and at the same rate for the period of such
extension of your term of service as may become necessary, ~~so far~~
as enables you to complete the course.

(2) Lodging allowance at the rate of 2/- per diem ~~in the
cost of your having to enter upon your
travels, and at the rate of 1/- per diem if you are
traveling on the Direct.~~

(3) Traveling allowance of 5/- per diem.

(4) Return place railway and steamer passage between your
place of residence and Dublin, going and returning, on production of
receipts in support of the passage made.

These receipts should be forwarded direct to the Orange...
for the Colleagues, who will be instructed to pay the amount due to you
together with the allowances above mentioned.

No claim for ~~reimbursement~~ for traveling expenses other than
those specified, will be entertained.

6. The Secretary of State, however, reserves the right of
calling upon you to refund any portion of the allowance or traveling expenses
paid to you in accordance with the terms of the foregoing paragraph, in the
event of your failing to submit a satisfactory report of the circumstances
existing.
