No. 106 At meeting of Heads of Department
with one unofficial member it has been decided to
endeavour to move the whole of Indian Bazaar in com-
pliance with suggestion of Williams. It is necessary
to drain and lay out new Bazaar and native location first
however, the Committee strongly recommend that part of
drainage to town and flushing water main should be
undertaken before the main (interconnecting) sewer.
In view of state of town during the rains and urgent
necessity for partially draining site of permanent
offices, jail, and police lines to be built this
year request permission to proceed at once as proposed
with amount £2,000,000
