I am directed by the Secretary of State for the Colonies to inform you that, subject to your being passed as physically fit for service, he proposes to select you for ~~provisional~~ appointment as ~~Assistant~~ <sup>time for</sup> ~~time for~~ Assistant Engineer in the ~~Colonial~~ <sup>Government</sup> of the ~~Protectorate~~ <sup>of the</sup> with salary at the rate of £350 during annual engagements of 245 to 240 per annum and free quarters or an allowance ~~in lieu thereof~~.

2. A memorandum showing the general conditions attached to appointments in the Protectorate is enclosed herewith, but you are to understand that you will be subject to any regulations which may hereafter be introduced by or with the consent of the Secretary of State.

3. If you are prepared to accept the appointment in these ~~colonies~~ <sup>as</sup> ~~Protectorate~~ <sup>Government</sup> ~~conditions~~, you should present yourself to the Medical Officer of this Department, whose ~~name~~ <sup>name</sup> is on the annexed letter, for the purpose of being medically examined. The letter is to be detached and left with him, and you will be required to pay him a fee of one guinea. He will send his report direct to this Department.

1. I wish to request that you will state whether you accept this offer, and if so, when you will inform me of the particular date of which you will be prepared to leave for the Province.

2. You should at the same time furnish me with an address to which communications intended for your relatives or friends may be sent during your absence from this country.

3. The period of my stay will be for the years from now until next January and you will receive £200 a month for the State and a hundred pounds for County or Intercourse allowance. The amount of our leave arrangements for the future, from time to time, will be subject to regulation by superior officers in view of the regulations.
