#### ZEVANJARI SITIS & NATIVE HOUSING LOAN

Following is the completion of the report of the Legislative Council proceedings which took place on Friday, the first portion of which, dealing with the Zevanjari, was published on Saturday.

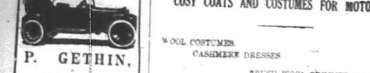

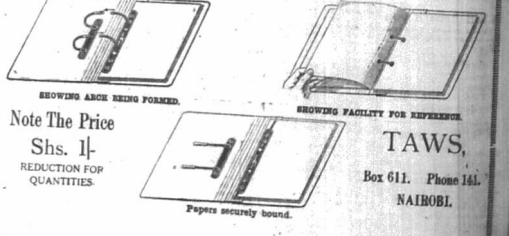
