

## OUR LONDON LETTER

Valuable Work by the Food Council.

### THE WAR ON THE MIDDLEMEN.

#### The Problem of the Modern Girl.

#### REDUCTION IN PRICE OF BREAD

[From Our Own Correspondent]

London, Oct. 12.

If ever they have Socialism in mind, the English should be entirely due to the Middlemen. They are the ones who fix the prices, the public is a perfectly innocent victim. These men have the highest cost of living but the lowest income. They are not content with reason, they are not satisfied with what is right. Having started by an attack on the food factor, the Government has announced that the bakeries must be brought into line. They were to charge 3d per lb. less than the price fixed by the Incorporated Bakers' Association. The price of Principal Wheatmeal

is to take one after the other and the public are quite ready to pay the bill when it may be taken. They have the right to do so. The latest statement of the short weight which is noted out to purchasers, has come from a paper of the Daily Mirror. It is a report from a meeting at Cheltenham of the Eastern County Councils. The Councils have been in touch with regard to samples of milk taken from 150 different farms. The average out of six in Wiltshire, four out of 15 in Wiltshire, two out of three in Wiltshire, and so on. In Wiltshire 24 out of three Wiltshire Milkmen are out of three. The men are out of work because of severe slacking and in London, according to the paper, the price of bread is up while the price of flour is down. The men are asking for a reduction of 2d per lb. in the price of flour. They have never received any such reduction.

#### VEGETABLES.

This short article affects us all who sell over the counter in vegetable markets, such as Market Drayton. Vegetable Market recently and so many men have been dismissed. Prices for vegetables have been raised to 3d per quarter pound. Since the publication of the above, the price of bread has fallen both in London and in the provinces, but not very much. The Bakers' associations have agreed at a meeting held on Oct. 10 in London that no reduction should be made in the price of bread. It is not quite clear whether the price of standard straight loaves will be increased or not. We have to day given further notice to the associations that, bearing in mind the present price of flour there is no room for a reduction in the price of bread. The associations are asked to make no reduction.

The report was issued by Lord Birkenhead, Chairman of the Food Council, asking all the bread bakers to hold the price of bread at prices below the present fixed by the two London Bakers' Associations. The British Bakers' Society of Principals, Wholesale and Retailers, and the London Master Bakers and Confectioners' Protection Society, about 150 members, have addressed, with their selling prices, the Food Council, 23 Sanctuary Buildings, Gt. Smith Street, London, S.W. CAPITULATION.

Within ten hours the Bakers had responded and issued the following notice: "We are informed that the recent resolution of the British Bakers' Society of Principals, Wholesale and Retailers, that all bread should be sold at a minimum price of 1/- per lb. will be effective from Oct. 1st, 1928. We, however, take this action with great gladness, because they have stated that the price of bread will be reduced from 1/- to 8/- per lb. per loaf." This is the best news for us all.

Later, the following notice appeared: "The London Master Bakers and Confectioners' Protection Society have decided to reduce the price of bread to 8/- per lb. per loaf. This, however, took effect on Oct. 1st, 1928. They thought it would be to their benefit to have the same price as the others, and so some of the more progressive Societies have lowered their price to 8/- as they say that at a good profit can be got from these figures."

GOVERNMENT CREDIT.

To the Government, the situation in Africa is very serious. The First World War has been a great drain upon the people, who do not receive any compensation. In 1914-15, the country was in a state of war, but there has been no compensation for that. The country has been out of the field since 1918. The Union Conference, Jan. 1928,




