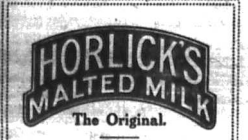

## RAINS IN SOUTH AFRICA

### Extensive Floods.

The South African papers report extensive floods in various parts. Certainly not since 1917, and perhaps even not then, has the central area of Natal and Zululand suffered so much from torrential rains, and to a less degree this applies to the main line, while the Durban catchment area reports record falls.

The Umgeni River became a swirling mass of flood waters which brought down masses of vegetation from its upper banks in such quantities that the railway bridge near Durban was subjected to terrific pressure. The water had reached seven feet above normal.

The 400-foot pier erected by the contractors constructing the new bridge which was built to straddle huge concrete cylinders, and to sink to the river's bottom, could not stand the pressure, and a big break was torn piece-meal in the pier just before the railway bridge. The damage done by the breaking up of this pier has been estimated at some £1,000.

The railway time-table was upset. The bridge had to be crossed at a speed of not more than 10 miles an hour.

All fields and low-lying ground have been flooded, and extensive damage has been done. The train lines at the Umgeni terminus were covered in mud washed from higher land.

### ZULULAND.

There has been no rain in Zululand. The total rainfall in Eshowe up to 8 a.m. on March 19 was over 28 inches. This, as far as Eshowe is concerned, exceeds the rainfall during the floods of 1917-18.

As Umfolosi the position has been serious the mill being out completely and its inhabitants marooned. The cotton crops are seriously affected. Apart from the cotton, which was nearly ruined, the maize disease is attacking the crops.

The sugar lands are not seriously affected, though some fields have been flooded out. The Eshowe area was unable to produce.

Unusually heavy rains have fallen throughout the Cape Province and native territories. Since January 1 some parts of the Malaya district have had 15 in. of rain. Durban during the same period had 20 in. of rain, and Durban, Durban, which is the highest at 16 inches, recorded for the period since 1890.

At Capetown the train service was discontinued owing to wash-aways.

### TUGELA BRIDGE.

A phenomenal rise took place in the Tugela River during the week-end, and so alarmingly rapid was the rise of the flood waters that by 3 o'clock that morning the river had swollen to the abnormal height of 45 to 50 feet above normal.

The new road bridge over the Tugela built in 1924 at the cost of £22,000 was unable to withstand the strain, and the steel girder network caved in beneath the weight of the flood.

The railway bridge, 300 yards or so higher up the river than the bridge at Broad's Drift, was entirely covered by the waters of the Killy and other tributaries of the Tugela, but it held out. So extraordinary rapid was the rise in the river's level that Indian steamers near the bank were covered until not even the iron rails could be seen; while the water passed all previous heights, until the railway station was surrounded. The water rose some feet up the side of the station buildings, and when the station foreman finally left his post he had to fight his way for 300 yards through over four feet of water.

### SHAKES.

The rains have had the effect of bringing to light a few specimens of snakes and some of them have been found washed ashore on the beach between the Pines at Durban and the Umgeni mouth.

The reptiles are of all kinds, but have been reported to be the commonest, 1-2 inches.

#### MOTOR TRANSPORT IN THE FARM.

It is a frequent complaint by the farmer that he cannot well do his present work to advantage. The household, too, has extensive grounds to cultivate. When both profession and domestic grumble there must be something wrong. If the farmer lives away from the big centre he must pay considerable mileage on his produce, and take all sorts of risks in addition, with this and extra handling till the sale is completed and he has his cheque. It is as risky as not that he is actually the loser for having raised, say, a load of produce. Thus the farmer's genuine reason for grumbling. Who can say it is absurd? Surely the labourer's work of a reward however small. The householder who has to buy produce complete as much as the farmer because of the high price he has to pay. Take for example the case of the farmer living at a distance of 30 miles from the centre to which he markets his produce. He has to load his produce and unload it at the market and provide the handling till it reaches the consumer. When a railway station exists perhaps some relief is obtained from the farm, but it is not near the sort of saving for freight and unloading of freight. That is to say he has to handle his produce for handling, he had five or six times, in addition to providing road transport for such loads, with mileage in return. Trucks that are loaded and unladen and due to delay and change in transit he produce returns are made by the farmer complete. For reasons of time and the uncertainties of delivery, the farmer's produce is sold at a price which is less than the price which he would get if he were to sell it himself. This is not suggested, or argued, that in the most future it will be caused to be by any means by the average farmer, but just as there have grown up auxiliary business in other branches of farm work, so there is likely to be a development of a new branch of farm business.

The talk upon the case of the farmer is not new from the general public. Individually, perhaps, he may not be able to meet the bill either for a motor transport vehicle or, if he possessed one, he could find profitable employment for it continuously. But in the aggregate, with his labouring the competition, takes in a different aspect. A distance of 30 miles each way is only a short stage for a motor

wagon, and delivery may be done from producer to consumer, with a minimum of handling and higher prices for produce condition. Ordinarily is afforded the farmer, without undue expense from home, of keeping in direct touch with the market. Even when it is impossible for him to dispense with a number of men, perhaps their condition or, at the least, he has the means to hand, which he cannot otherwise have of bringing them to reason, for competition is a ruling factor in taking produce. And having disposed of his own goods to the best advantage, he may secure the return load of supplies, either for his own or his neighbour's farm, in the most favourable manner. It is not proposed to show what the operating costs and capabilities of any particular type of motor vehicle would be working under varying conditions, an attempt to do so would necessitate assuming different cost figures for fuel, lubricants, labour, etc. Figures which at the best would be only approximate, and which are best put at their proper value by the farmer himself with the assistance of local expert advice. It is certain, however, that in farming the motor transport vehicle will justify itself in many ways. To make it pay, of course, the motor wagon must be made to do all the work it can safely perform, for only under these conditions can the fund element of the cost of operation be held down to a satisfactory small percentage of the total cost per unit of service rendered.

#### COMMERCIAL MOTOR TRAILERS.

One of the most important uses of the motor vehicle in commercial employment is in the transport of commercial goods, and it is not surprising that they shall be made to do their maximum safe capacity during the largest possible proportion of their working time.
