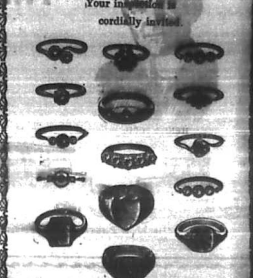

PORT TERMAN SMASH.

Emergency Finding.

Mr. B. A. Ocran, the Nairobi Magistrate, issued the following finding upon his enquiry into the circumstances surrounding the Port Terman Railway accident at Mile 529/16, in the neighbourhood of Port Terman, 7 up goods train from Nakuru was derailed on the evening of the 15th April last, about 7 o'clock p.m. and the driver, Mr. John Jeopoy, and two native firemen were killed by this derailment.

All those who were on the footplate at the time of the accident, in the absence of evidence from someone who was on the footplate at the time of the accident, it is somewhat difficult to come to a definite conclusion as to what were the actual causes of the accident for the reason that the evidence for the time of the accident is but inconsiderable. It is, however, to be noted that the evidence collected was in imminent peril of death, and was unobtainable some time after the accident, his evidence cannot be taken as accurate as to the details of what happened immediately prior to the derailment of it.

In addition to these unfortunate people who were killed, Guard Smith is the only person who was on the train, he gives evidence, but in considering his evidence, it must be remembered that as he realised he was in imminent peril of death, and was unobtainable some time after the accident, his evidence cannot be taken as accurate as to the details of what happened immediately prior to the derailment.

THE PHYSICAL FEATURES.

Before dealing with the evidence, I think it well to mention what the physical features are at the point mile 529/16 where the accident occurred and the vicinity thereof. The station is at Mile 524 1/2 and from there down to Mile 529/16 there is a down grade of 2 per cent. At Mile 529, about where the accident occurred, there is a cutting, or a 10 degree curve in the line and on each side of the cutting there is a bank of rock. At the entrance to the cutting the engine and the goods train were on the down grade in relation to 1.85 per cent. The banks of rock on each side of the cutting are about 20 feet high and the line of the bank is facing towards Port Terman that the engine crashed when it left the rails.

I have inspected the permanent way at and about Mile 529/16. I have heard evidence as to its condition, and from my view of it, and the evidence given as to it, I find that it could not possibly have been the cause of the derailment of the engine. The engine, Westinghouse brake-driver's valve, pump, gauge, and governor, were tested by Mr. Emley after the accident, and were all found by him to be in first-class working order. And as the engine was new, and as I take Mr. Emley's evidence to be correct, I do not see that the accident can be attributed to any flaw in the engine, or any deficiency in the Westinghouse brake apparatus. The fact that the brakes were in order is corroborated by evidence, that after the derailment, brakes were found to be fully applied on eight of the trucks of the train, and by evidence that the train was brought to a walking pace at Mile 523 by an application of the brakes. There is also evidence before me which I accept, that the weight and units of the train were within the engine's hauling power and control, so I do not consider that overloading could be a cause of the accident.

TRAIN MANAGEMENT.

With the permanent way, engine and brake apparatus and overloading eliminated as causes of the accident, the next point remaining to be considered as a cause of the accident is the management of the train, and as to

this I would make reference to the three following railway regulations, the first of which requires a train to be driven at a speed exceeding eight miles an hour, when going through a station where there are points, the second regulation is to the effect that a train going down a 2 per cent down grade must not exceed 20 miles an hour and the third and most important one for consideration of this enquiry is that a train at the cutting, where this derailment took place, is forbidden to exceed 15 miles an hour. This last regulation has been in force since January, 1919, and has been published in the Weekly Traffic Notices every week since the 4th January, 1919. A copy of which is sent to all drivers once a week.

The evidence given proves that this train passed through Tunnel Station, where there are points, at a speed of 35 miles an hour, whereas by regulation it should not have exceeded eight miles an hour, that on the down grade from that station, it was driven at a speed of 45 miles an hour, when by regulation it should not have exceeded 20 miles an hour, and that it entered the cutting on a 10 degree curve at a speed of 45 miles an hour, when by regulation 15 miles an hour is the maximum speed permitted. In addition to this evidence, it is stated by the guard that the driver applied a 35 lb. brake pressure when in the tunnel, which is some two miles from the point of accident, and that the accident arose only after the gauge dropped to zero, when the guard realised that an accident was inevitable and thrust himself on the floor of the brake van, and that he had applied his hand brake without effect. In these circumstances, which were most trying to the guard, he realised that his life was in danger and therefore his attention was to the exact point when the brake was actually applied, and I think he taken as correct.

It is stated by the guard that he says the brake gauge showed a 35 lb. pressure on coming out of the tunnel immediately after he says it went below the zero curve, the course of a few seconds later the train crashed. Now the tunnel is roughly about two miles from the scene of the accident, the incident of applying the brake could not have taken more than 30 seconds in all, and as the train crashed off the line at the end of the tunnel, and I am inclined to think that the brake must have been applied when the train was quite near the entrance to the cutting and not at the tunnel as stated by the guard. If a 35 lb. pressure were applied two miles off Mile 529/16, and kept applied, it would easily have stopped the train; for it is recognised fact that a train with a 35 lb. pressure on such as one had, could be pulled up by a 35 lb. application of the Westinghouse brake in or about 500 yards, therefore I come to the conclusion that the brake was applied when the train was immediately approaching the cutting and 10 to 15 degrees curve at 529/16, and such application was worse than useless for, according to the expert evidence given, a heavy pressure of brake power applied on a 10 degree curve would tend to curve on a single off the line.

SPEED MISJUDGED.

On considering all the facts, it appears to me that the driver misjudged the speed at which the train was travelling when it was approaching the cutting and 10 to 15 degrees curve at 529/16, and that, though he applied his brake, he did so far too late for it to have its full effect.

The cause of the engine jumping the line was in my opinion the excessive speed at which the train attempted to go round the above curve, which excessive

to misjudged and faulty manipulation of the Westinghouse brake by the driver.

Though driver John Jeopoy from Tunnel Station to the point of accident broke every rule and regulation of the Railway as to speed, his untimely death is to be very much regretted, and sympathy must be extended to his relatives. And as to the two native firemen who were on the footplate of the engine with him, I would point out, that the English Workmen's Compensation is not applicable to this Colony, that they met their deaths by an accident through no fault or negligence on their part, and that the accident arose out of, and in the course of their employment.

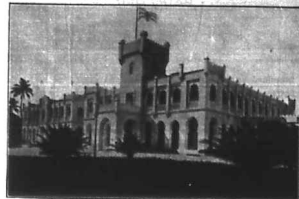


